# What's in your Bible? Lesson 1: Basics

If we want to learn what God wants us to do, we need to learn how to handle His word, the Holy Bible. Let's be sure of these basic rules:


#### TABLE OF CONTENTS

The books of the Bible are printed in the front of most Bibles. They are listed by Old and New Testament, and sometimes alphabetically, showing the page to find each. Look in your own Bible and find what page the following books start on.

#### CHAPTERS & VERSES

The books in the Bible are divided into chapters, which are shown as large numbers on each page. The chapters are divided into verses, which are the little numbers. Verses in the Bible to be looked up are called scripture references. They are written in a special way: the book name first, then the chapter number, followed by a colon (:), and finally the verse number.



Verse numbers are always <u>after</u> the colon. A dash means everything between the two numbers.






